

## NEW ZEALAND'S PREMIER BEADING SUPPLY STORE Button Angel Decoration



## **INGREDIENTS:**

- 9 x buttons gradually decreasing in size from large to small (they must be drilled like a shirt button).
- 1 x pair of wings with a hole through the middle
- 1 x 8mm facet (we used clear) for the head
- 2 x size 6 seed beads or similar for the legs
- 30cm of tigertail
- 3 x crimp beads
- 20 30 cm of ribbon

## **TOOLS**

A Bead Mat to work on Wire Cutters Chain Nose Pliers

## **RECIPE**

- 1. Take your tigertail and slide a crimp over both ends toward the middle until you have a small loop (3 4 mm). Squash the crimp bead firmly.
- 2. Slide on (over BOTH strands of wire) the facet and the wings.
- 3. Now thread on the buttons from smallest to largest, using one peice of tigertail down one line of button holes and the second piece down the other side of button holes
- 4. Slide a small 'foot bead' and then a crimp down each end piece of wire.
- 5. Make sure the beads and buttons are tight to the top loop then squash each end crimp firmly.
- 6. Thread the ribbon through the top loop and knot the ends together so your angel can hang.
